DAY 1

Arrival in Hong Kong.

Places to visit: Jockey Club Innovation Tower, Bank of China Tower, studio visit.

Topics of discussion: Relationship of the built environment with the ecological system, understanding environmental policies and impact.

Places to visit: ZCB, free afternoon.

Topics of discussion: Protection of heritage in built spaces.

Places to visit: M+ Museum, Tai Kwun Centre and West Kowloon Pavillion.

Topics of discussion: Integration of green spaces and usable community gathering spaces.

Places to visit: Chu Hai College, Central Harbor Front event space.

DAY 7

Topics of discussion: Sustainable transportation and public transit system.

Places to visit: Hong Kong Institute of Design, studio visit.

Topics of discussion: Land reclamation, building with the challenges of HK's terrain.

Places to visit: Victoria Harbour, Central and Wan Chai projects, Opus, HK Observation Wheel.
